**Training terms, conditions and prices** 1/5/2013  
**All prices quoted include 10% GST where applicable**

- Training** \$300 per week (includes GST) Minimum of twelve (12) weeks (or by negotiation) Includes training at any level, board and feed. Feeding at shows is included in training costs.
- Board** \$30 per day per horse. Limited availability. (stable or yard)
- Agistment** \$60 per week, Limited availability, hay only, owner to provide hard feed if required.
- Other charges**  
Farrier, dentistry and veterinarian work will be billed directly to client  
Hire charges for indoor arena if travelling offsite as part of preparing for a show will be included on next account (normally between \$20-\$25 per horse). To be discussed with owner prior to occurring.
- Hauling**  
Melbourne metropolitan area e.g. Werribee \$110 return trip  
Garfield & Tonimbuk arenas \$44 return trip  
Sydney \$700 return trip, \$400 one way  
Shepparton and return \$180 + GST (\$198)  
Minimum of three horses must be transported by Gene Redwood to interstate shows or shows outside Melbourne metropolitan, otherwise we reserve the right to negotiate with 1) owners who transport their own horse(s) and/or 2) owners whose horse we are transporting to cover our travel costs. Other destinations quoted upon request.
- Entries** Entries for local shows (entries on the day) are either billed on next account if owner is not attending or paid by owner at the show. State, national and futurity shows (NPHA, Australian Halter Showcase etc) where entries are due prior to the show are the owner's responsibility.

**Membership** Please discuss with Gene before entering him in a class. Gene Redwood will maintain membership with the following associations for showing purposes each year. Should membership with another association be required for the showing of a particular horse(s) e.g. Australian Appaloosa Association, all joining fees will be payable by the relevant horses owner for that year.

**Camping fees at shows** Camping/parking fees will be split between the number of horses attending the show with Gene.

**Showing charges**  
Horses in training – Nil  
Horses not in training – catch ride \$66 per class minimum or according to prior mutual arrangement. Halter class \$44 per class minimum or according to prior mutual arrangement. Prizes and paybacks as listed below apply. The above prices do not include preparation of the horse.

**Day charge** \$20 per day or by negotiation. This includes usage and maintaining of all show gear etc. Day charge is open to negotiation if owners are able to assist at shows by cleaning stables, checking waters and helping to prepare horses. Where not provided, bedding at shows will be purchased and included on the following account or can be provided by owners.

**Show preparation**  
Owners are encouraged to band and prepare their own horses at shows. If not available please let us know and we will organise for your horse to be banded etc.  
Banding fee if completed by us \$33. If we are unavailable a banding fee will be charged at the rate charged by the person employed to band the horse.

**Prizes & payback**  
10% of gross payback/prize money goes to the trainer/rider. Ribbons/garlands/trophies go to the owner. Gene Redwood reserves the right to retain buckles, or have duplicates made at owners expense, or by negotiation, of specific Futurity champions trained and shown by him. eg. 2yo futurity at NPHA

**Lessons** Horses in training – no additional charge, maximum one, one hour lesson per week. Lessons can only be accrued for one month before forfeiting. Lessons must be with horse in training. Lessons without horse in training - \$90 per lesson (approximately one hour in duration), includes travel within 10km radius, otherwise travel and/or arena hire charges apply.

**Clinics** One day clinic, approximately eight hours \$500  
Two day clinic, approximately eight hours per day \$950.  
Additional days at \$450 per day.

Transport additional and by negotiation  
All meals and accommodation are to be provided for Gene Redwood for duration of clinic.

- Accounts** Accounts are issued every four weeks from day of arrival or by negotiation. The first two weeks training is payable on arrival of the horse into training. Accounts will be for the previous two weeks and the next two weeks. Accounts are generally emailed, please let us know if you would prefer an alternative method. Please let us know if there are any problems with the accounts you receive or if there will be any delay in payment, otherwise we expect that all accounts will be paid within 7 days of invoice date.  
No horse maybe removed from the premises until all accounts are settled in full. Interest maybe charged on all late accounts at the rate of 10% of balance owing per week. Payment maybe made by cash, cheque or direct deposit into a nominated bank account. Should a horse be unable to complete training previously paid due to illness or injury, the balance will be credited towards further training.
- Commission** Horses/gear sold through Gene Redwood maybe subject to a 10% commission. Please check with Gene prior to sale for any conditions that may apply.
- Horse rugs** Owners are requested to supply a minimum of 2 light summer rugs and 1 heavy set suitable for paddock conditions (e.g. lined canvas). Show horses will require a doona set, an additional light set for shows and a skinny hood. It is the owner's responsibility to launder rugs on a regular basis.
- Farrier** Gene Redwood reserves the right to employ a farrier of his choice. Farrier accounts will be forwarded to owners for payment directly to farrier. If an owner prefers to employ a farrier of their choice, please discuss with Gene. Owners using their own farrier must be present at appointment time and settle accounts directly with farrier. Please check with Gene prior to booking any outside farrier.
- General** All horses are to be wormed prior to arrival. Regular worming of all horses in training will be undertaken and costs included on next account (approximately \$20 per wormer).  
All horses must arrive in good health and be sound. Gene Redwood reserves the right to request a vet check of any horse at his discretion and at the owner's expense.  
We reserve the right to return or refuse any horse that is felt to be unsafe.

Whilst your horse is in training, whether it be at our establishment, a show, or in transit, all care will be taken to prevent accident, injury, illness or death. Whilst all care will be taken by Gene Redwood and staff they can not be held liable for any injury, illness or death that may occur. Gene Redwood reserves the right to employ a veterinarian when treatment is necessary at the owner's expense. Where urgent action is required and the owner is not contactable, Gene Redwood, in conjunction with the treating veterinarian, reserves the right to make decisions in the best interest of the horse. Please include on the horse care record form any details regarding the emergency treatment you prefer of your horse(s) together with any insurance details that maybe relevant.

**It is requested that Sunday be left as our family day (when not at shows) and that no general enquiries or visits take place.**
